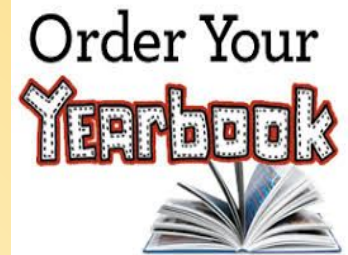

2019-2020 Class Lists

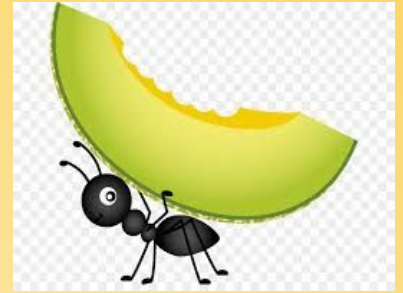
An important informational item!
