Entries are to be submitted to the classroom teacher on Friday, November 8th. All entries submitted will be returned.



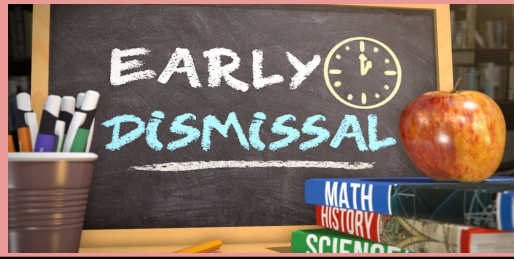
Colder Weather

We want your children to enjoy their outdoor activities and stay warm!



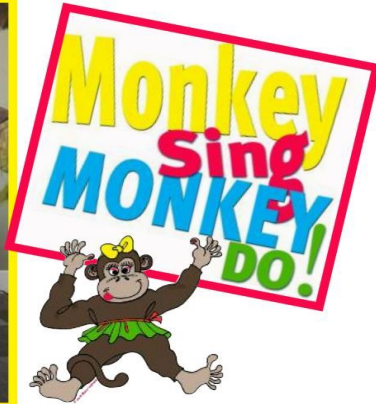
Early Dismissal -
